-Construction of patio covers, rooms, storage sheds, large playground equipment, basketball goals, or fences must have prior approval from the Architectural Control Committee.

The Cypress Mill deed restrictions created the Cypress Mill Architectural Control Committee (CMACC) to enforce its restrictions. Its members have a strong commitment to resolve chronic violations.
