Oak Wilt Presentation – David Obermann introduced the speaker, COA arborist and oak wilt specialist Chris Dolan. His talk covered how the fungal infection is initiated, spreads, species susceptible, possible treatments including trenching and infusion, affected areas, and distributed educational materials. The contents of his presentation will be publicized to all area residents in an article in the HPWBANA newsletter.
