TETHER DIVING (Arc Search)



- Diver swims a series of arcs of decreasing radius with Tender remaining in one location.
- Tender controls reversal locations.
- Diver must maintain taut tether.
- Diver must constantly be feeling for line signals from Tender.



EQUIPMENT



Harness:

- Worn under BC
- Off center chest attachment D-ring
- Tether line attached with locking carabiner.

Tether Line:

- No longer than 150 ft.
- Buoyant swift-water rescue line.

• Contingency Line:

- Attached to Back-up diver's harness
- Attached to primary diver's tether line
- 5" to 7" in length with quick release

LINE SIGNALS (To Diver)



- 1 Pull Stop, face line, take up slack and prepare for new signal.
- 3 Pulls Go to diver's right
- 4 Pulls Go to diver's left
- 2+2 Pulls Search immediate area
- 3+3 Pulls Standby and prepare to surface.
- 4+4 Pulls Surface



LINE SIGNALS (From Diver)



- 1 Pull I am OK
- 2 Pulls Tender make note
- 6 Pulls Found target
- 2+2+2 Pulls Entangled but OK
- 3+3+3 Pulls OK but need help from back up diver.
- 4+4+4 Pulls Need help immediately.



Layout

PRIMARY DIVER
Responds to Tender
and executes search
pattern



PROFILER
Keeps a record of search including
Primary Diver's discoveries, position, and status.



- Tender
- Primary Diver
- 100% Backup Diver
- Profiler
- 90% Backup Diver

90% BACKUP DIVER
Ready to respond if problem escalates.
Ready to go with some notice.

100% BACKUP DIVER Ready to respond if Primary Diver is in trouble. Full Gear.



TENDER
Controls and Monitors
the Diver in the Water
(Primary Diver's Tender)




Deploy







- Profiler Starts Map of Target Area using fixed landmarks
- Tender starts search pattern by paying out rope. Tells profiler amount of rope.
- Diver backs into water taking up slack from Tender
- Profiler records Divers beginning air and initial position.
- Backup Divers Stand By






Begin







- Diver Descends and starts swimming pattern.
- Tender watches diver.
- Diver Communicates with tender via rope or radio
- Profiler records progress






Turn (Divers left)







- Tender stops Diver with one pull as arc reaches edge of pattern
- Diver stops and turns to face Tender
- Tender pays out known length of line
- Diver Takes up slack
- Tender gives 4 pulls to signal diver to turn to his left and begin searching again.
- Diver turns to the left and continues pattern
- Profiler records length of line paid out.






Continue







- Pattern continues to the right.
- Diver Searches.
- Tender watches Diver
- Profiler records progress.





Turn (Divers Right)










- Tender stops Diver with one pull as arc reaches edge of pattern
- Diver stops and turns to face Tender
- Tender pays out known length of line.
- Diver Takes up slack
- Tender gives 3 pulls to signal diver to turn to his right and begin searching again.
- Diver turns to the right and continues pattern
- Profiler records length of line paid out.






Profiler's Map
