

# Campsite Checklist

## While Setting Up Camp

### Site

Chosen according to Leave No Trace Guidelines

Kitchen area and tent locations determined before camp setup begins

### Tents

Tents properly pitched to keep out wind and rain?

Guylines tied with correct knots and properly staked down?

Ground cloths under tents to shield tent floors from abrasion and ground moisture?

### Personal Gear and Bedding

Sleeping Bags and pads stowed inside the tents

Clothing and other personal gear neatly stored in packs

### Kitchen Area

Dining Fly set up?

Food stowed to keep it safe from weather and wildlife

Sited for stoves or open flames properly prepared using leave not trace guidelines

Planes made for wastewater disposal

Soap and water set out for Scouts to wash hands before cooking and eating

### Latrine

Toilet facilities require cleaning or other attention?

General locations of cat holed are understood by all?

Scouts trained in use of cat holed and latrines?

Toilet paper on hand?

## During the Campout

### Site

Area clean and orderly? Litter picked up?

### Tents

Kept Taut? Bedding and personal gear neatly stowed?

### Kitchen

Food properly stored?

Utensils and dishes kept clean and orderly?

Cooking and dining areas neat?

Patrols following duty rosters for meal preparation and cleanup[?]

Dishwater disposal and management of trash and leftovers disposed of according to Leave No Trace guidelines?

### Scouts

Appropriately dressed for weather and the activities?

Following personal cleanliness habits (Within reason)?

General Health OK?

## While Breaking Camp

Personal and group gear packed and ready for the trip home'

Trash packed for transport?

All cat holes properly covered? All toilet paper disposed of properly?

In permanent fire sites, fires cold out and fireplaces cleaned of any litter and bits of leftover food>

Where appropriate, a courtesy firewood supply left for next campers>
